Note: OBEY SPEED LIMITS. There is no time limit or time element to this Rally.

Please answer the questions and deposit your answers in the box provided in the registration room. This is not a "group" endeavor and consulting with other cars and drivers is not in the spirit of this drive and not fair to others driving alone.

- **START:** Course begins at the traffic light just past the NYS Thruway Geneva exit 42 toll booth. Set your odometer to 0.

*Mileage readings are approximate and as recorded in a Ford.
These are the odometer readings and not the distance between points.*

- *Directions start with bullets and questions are numbered.*

Questions through the end of the rally route are in the order that the things appear. If you get to the next direction you missed the clue that will help provide the answer.

- At the stop sign go straight across Main Street. 21.7 miles

- At the stop sign go straight across Seneca Street onto Geneva Street. 21.8 miles

- Follow Geneva Street around the corner and onto Margaret Street.

- At the stop sign turn right onto Kings Hill Road. (no street sign) 22.0 miles

Caution – multiple sets of slightly rough railroad tracks – go slow over them, approach the hill at an angle and you should not have a problem. Watch for trains too at the upper set of tracks that do not have a signal!

- Stop and then make a right turn onto Perry Point Road and after stopping again make an immediate left onto Route 14 southbound. 22.6 miles
