Start of Rally

Exit 48A off of Route 90, Make a right off the exit or Route 5 East

Route 5 East at 77.

Junction of Route 5 and Route 77 is the starting point. Set you odometer to 0.

Proceed east on route 5.

Question 1: What is the DOktor's speciality? $\qquad$

Take your first right after the Doktor's place of business.

At Red barn/garage on left, you are at 2 miles.

Question 2: As you reach the $T$, what is the number on the Boyce road sign? $\qquad$ (3.4 miles)

Make a left at the T.

Make your next right.

Question 3: Name the road you make a right on. $\qquad$

Question 4: What is on the top of the red mail box? $\qquad$

Question 5: What is the sign before the bridge? $\qquad$

Question 6: How many deer are on the fence posts? $\qquad$

Question 7: How many red out buildings does the green house have? $\qquad$

Question 8: At Sumner Road, what is the name of the lake? $\qquad$

Continue straight across Sumner Road.

Left on Sharick Rd.

Make a right on Harper Road.

Question 9: Whose Old Country Store/pepsi sign? $\qquad$

Left at $T$.

Reality check: Right on Route 238 at approximately 8.6 miles.

Question 10: What is the name of the construction company? $\qquad$

Question 11: How many silo's next to the green barn on right? $\qquad$

Question 12: What is the name of the camp ground? $\qquad$

Question 13: There are three flags, what are they? $\qquad$ - $\qquad$ - $\qquad$

Question 14: When is the Attica Rodeo? $\qquad$

Watch your speed!

Question 15: What county are you entering? $\qquad$

Question 16: Add up the route numbers that you see, minus the house number behind the " T " yellow arrow. Note! Keep moving, do not linger at corner. Get your information and leave!

Right at the T .

Reality check: You should be in the village at Attica. Make a left at Hans Moeller Jewelers.

Question 17: Name above door of bank next to Moeller's? $\qquad$

Question 18: Name of memorial library? $\qquad$

Just past Attica Central School, bear left on East Main Road.

Question 19: What is the obvious color of the barn on your left? $\qquad$

Reality check: At approximately 14.5 miles you should be passing a set of railroad tracks.

Question 20: What is the name of the cemetery? $\qquad$

At the blue silo bear left onto Capwell Road.

Question 21: How many silo's at the red barn? $\qquad$

Important, you are coming up to a high-center railroad track. Be careful and go VERY slow and crawl, at approximately 19 miles.

Continue straight on West Middlebury Road.

Enjoy this portion of the drive.

Question 21: After you pass W. Bethany, count silos on left til you T at Route 19.

Make/merge left on Route 19.

Question 22: What is the name of the first creek you come to? $\qquad$

As you exit Pearl Creek, proceed straight through to stop sign. Do not bear left, continue to stop sign.

Right on to Silver Lake Road.

Left on Old State Road.

Enjoy this portion and be careful of the tight corners.

Continue on Old State Road.

Bear right and continue on Old State Road. Do NOT go left onto Peoria.

Continue on Old State Road until it T's. Make a left.

Question 23: How many yellow arrow signs next to the white picket fence? $\qquad$

Reality check: At approximately 33.6 miles, you should be crossing a railroad track before you cross over Route 36. Old State Road turns into Chandler across Route 36.

Question 24: At the stop sign at Route 36, add up the road signs. $\qquad$

Proceed on Chandler. What your speed limit here, $\qquad$

Chandler T's at Route 63.

Question 25: Provide the numbers on the Chandler/Genesee Road signs and then add them up. $\qquad$

Right on Route 63.

Question 26: What river do you cross? $\qquad$

End of Rally.

To get to Corning: Proceed on 63 to 390 South.
